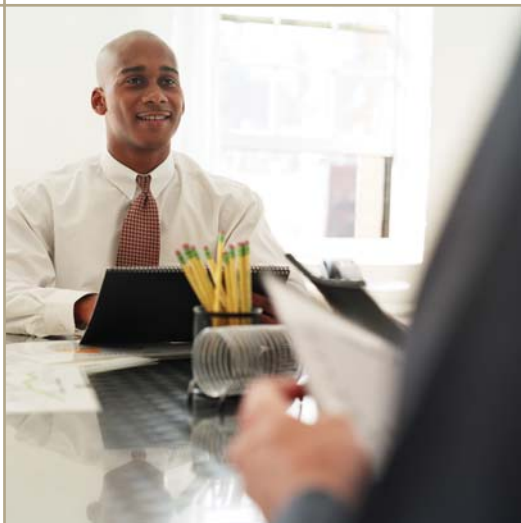

How Does The Programme Work?

Each module has a number of practical work-based coaching activities, together with self-directed learning exercises. At the end of each module there is an assessment which has to be completed and returned to Newcastle College for marking. The Diploma certificate is awarded on satisfactory completion of all modules, with accompanying assignments.

Distance learning – All course materials are mailed out and learners complete the six assessment workbooks and mail them back to Newcastle College for marking. This route is ideal if learners prefer to have their course pack to hand or if they have limited access to the internet.

E-learning/online study – Online study involves logging on to the Newcastle course website with a personal log-in and password; ideal if learners want instant access to the course and study at any place there is an internet connection.
